1 GENERAL BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2 ROLES RELATED TO THIS ADD-ON

Producer: Farmers/Growers that supply their products directly to Albert Heijn (AH) or to a supplier that in turn supplies AH.

Supplier: The entity that supplies products (fruit and vegetables) to AH and has a number of producers that also grow the products for them (i.e., the supplier) and/or that are connected to them (i.e., the supplier).

Service Provider: A company (e.g., processor, distributor, packer, etc.) that sources on behalf of AH, ensuring a supply of safe, quality products to the retail customer or the company that has been contracted to supply main product lines to that retail customer. This includes companies such as Bakker Barendrecht, Koninklijke Vezet, Nedato, Agrico, Leo de Kock, Vogelaar Vredehof, Oakfield, Banken Champignons/Hooza Trading, and Agarica.



3 GENERAL RULES SPECIFICATIONS

This document contains the general rules specifications exclusively applicable for the AH Beter voor Natuur & Boer (AH Beter voor) add-on. The basis for this document are the latest <u>GLOBALG.A.P. general add-on rules</u>, which should be consulted while reading these general rules specifications.

The GLOBALG.A.P. general regulations in their current version apply to the add-on unless otherwise specified in the add-on rules below.

a)	Applicant registration	Producers (directly or via suppliers) will be requested by the specific AH service provider to implement the AH Beter voor add-on.
		The service provider will provide the producer (directly or via supplier) the complete AH Beter voor documentation package. The supplier shall, once informed by the service provider, inform all their relevant producers about this add-on.
		Registration with the certification body (CB) can happen <i>only after</i> the producer has been informed by their supplier or service provider about the AH Beter voor add-on.
		Therefore, a producer can be registered with the CB only if one of the two possibilities is fulfilled:

		Possibility 1: The producer (or supplier) provides a documented copy of a current email that was sent directly from the service provider to the producer (or supplier) that confirms the request of the implementation of the AH Beter voor add-on;

		Possibility 2: An email can be sent directly from the service provider to the CB to indicate that the AH-Beter Voor add-on is requested for the producer.
c)	Information on approved CBs is available for every add-on and published on the GLOBALG.A.P. website.	Only CBs with final approval for GLOBALG.A.P. Integrated Farm Assurance (IFA), crops scope, fruit and vegetables (FV) sub-scope may register producers for the AH Beter voor add-on.
		CBs that want to conduct audits for the AH Beter voor add-on shall request a scope extension (see the latest GLOBALG.A.P. fee table for scope extension costs) from GLOBALG.A.P. CB administration by sending a signed letter of intent. The CB shall nominate an AH contact person and in-house trainer (IHT) at the same time.
		CB auditor fee: Not applicable if the CB auditor is already registered in the GLOBALG.A.P. database and is paying the fee for the IFA standard.

d)	The duration of the service contract is set between the CB and the producer.	The contract between the producer and CB is <i>independent</i> from AH and the GLOBALG.A.P. Secretariat.
		The CB shall include this add-on as part of the GLOBALG.A.P. sublicence and certification agreement that is signed between the CB and the producer.

5.1 Self-assessmer	nt	
a)	Self-assessments are required if the specific add-on includes this requirement in the control points and compliance criteria.	For Option 1 and Option 1 multisite without QMS: The producer shall conduct a self-assessment against all the applicable requirements of the AH Beter voor add-on.
		For Option 1 multisite with QMS: The QMS shall include the implementation of the AH Beter voor add-on. Internal audits (as conducted by internal auditors) shall include 100% of the production sites that supply to AH. Therefore, all these production sites shall receive an annual internal audit against the AH Beter voor add-on.
5.2 Second- or third	d-party assessments	
a)	A second (an appointed organization) or third party (an independent certification body) shall conduct the addon assessments.	The AH Beter voor add-on can be audited <i>only</i> by GLOBALG.A.P. <i>finally</i> approved CBs for IFA, crops scope, FV sub-scope. The CB auditors shall also have successfully completed the training on the add-on. (See section 7 for more details).

5.2.1 Option 1 – Inc	lividual producer (without QM	S)
a)	Producer receives an annual assessment.	The CB audits against the AH Beter voor add-on and the IFA standard are conducted in the same period. This period is a maximum of four weeks. The CB audits against the AH Beter voor add-on and the IFA standard may be conducted by different auditors.
		No benchmarked schemes are allowed.
		In the case of the initial/first CB audit of a producer against the AH Beter voor add-on, the add-on can be added mid- cycle. The AH Beter voor add-on can also be combined with an unannounced CB audit.
		The AH Beter voor add-on CB audit frequency is annual – similar to the IFA standard.
b)	The duration and timing of assessments will be part of the agreement with the CB.	The additional duration of the AH Beter voor CB audit will depend on the size of the farm and the complexity of production activities.

5.2.2 Option 1 – Inc	lividual producer with a QMS	
a)	The QMS and the production sites shall be assessed.	For multisites with a quality management system (QMS), the QMS shall be managed centrally. The implementation of the AH Beter voor add-on shall also be included as part of the QMS. The QMS shall be audited as stipulated in the GLOBALG.A.P. general regulations.
		It is preferred to conduct CB audits for the AH Beter voor add-on together with the IFA CB audit. However, separate audits are allowed as well. No benchmarked schemes are allowed.
		In the case of the initial/first CB audits of an Option 1 multisite with QMS against the AH Beter voor add-on, the add-on can be added mid-cycle. The AH Beter voor add-on can also be combined with an unannounced CB audit. The AH Beter voor add-on CB audit frequency is annual, similar to the IFA audit frequency for multisite with QMS.
b)	The CB does not assess all production sites, just a sample. It is not the responsibility of the CB to determine the compliance of each production site (this responsibility rests with the applicant). The CB shall assess whether the applicant's internal controls are appropriate.	The same sampling procedure as in the case of the IFA standard (for Option 1 multisite with a QMS) shall be followed. It is, however, important that the sample is representative of the producers that implement the AH Beter voor add-on.

a)	It is possible that a specific add-on requires that producers receive unannounced assessments.	This is <i>not</i> possible.
b)	If it is a requirement, 10% of the add-on producers or groups of a CB shall be assessed annually unless stated otherwise.	This is <i>not</i> possible.

6.1 Requirements for achieving and maintaining add-on conformance		
a)	The CPCC of the add-on may consist of different levels (e.g., knock-out points, Major Musts, Minor Musts, or Recommendations) or may have a scoring system.	The add-on consists of Major Must and Minor Must control points.

b)	For each add-on program, the constitution of the CPCC and v	conformance rules are based on the vill be stipulated.
c)	The compliance percentage shall be calculated taking into account all the control points applicable to each site and product.	Compliance with 100% of the Major Musts is required and a maximum of one non-compliance (per module) to a Minor Must is allowed to successfully conform with the AH Beter voor add-on. Furthermore, 28 days for corrective actions plus 28 days for the certification decision apply.
d)	In all cases, after an assessment, the calculation to show compliance (or noncompliance) shall be available.	To be discussed and agreed at closing meeting on-site as part of the summary of findings as presented by the CB auditor. The producer shall receive a copy of the summary of non-compliances at the end of the CB audit. Both the CB auditor and the producer shall sign this summary document.

6.5 Letter of conformance		A letter of conformance is issued by the CB once the producer complies with 100% of the Major Musts and has a maximum of one non-compliance (per module) to a Minor Must as per the AH Beter voor add-on.
		The validity period of the letter of conformance is 12 months. The validity period of the letter of conformance may be extended a maximum of 4 months. See Annex 2 of this document for a template of the letter of conformance.

		The IHT shall then train the CB auditors that will carry out audits against this add-on.
