

## **Resembling Scheme**

Red Tractor Assurance for Farms Fresh Produce Standards

As a resembling scheme, Red Tractor Assurance for Farms Fresh Produce Standards has its own G.A.P. requirements (Control Points and Compliance Criteria) and certification rules (General Regulations), which largely conform with the GLOBALG.A.P. System, but leave some exceptions.
